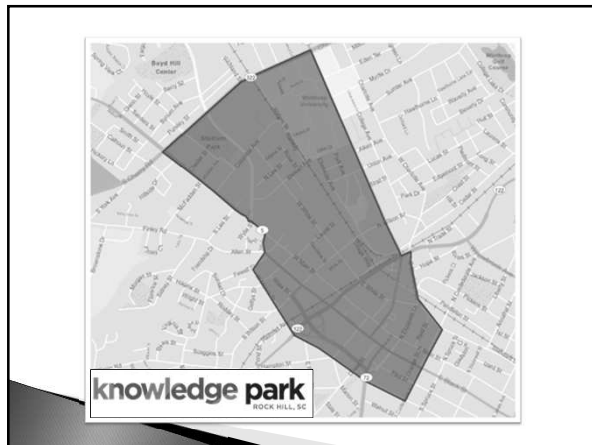

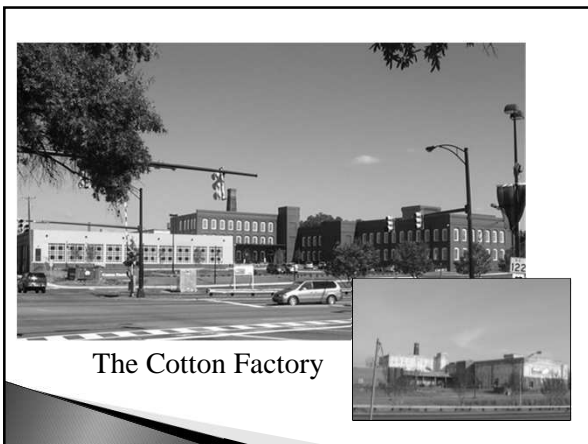
The Vision
