Meeting Information

Active shooter events continue to plague the United States. Since 2009, the number of active shooter events in the United States has tripled, and the lethality of these events has increased by 600%. This course provides public safety officials with key items to consider during the initial aftermath of an active shooter event. The second portion of the course will focus on the aftermath of these events, including ways that municipalities should respond after threat neutralization and patient care.

Municipal officials, risk managers, safety committee members and others who serve in a risk management role are encouraged to attend. Attendance at this meeting counts toward risk self-assessment compliance and as an elective course for participants in the Risk Management Institute.

Speaker**Mike Clumpner, President and Chief Executive Officer, Threat Suppression Incorporated**

Dr. Mike Clumpner is a 27-year veteran of the fire service, with 25 years' experience as a career firefighter/paramedic serving on high-call-volume fire companies. Clumpner is currently a full-time fire battalion chief with the Charlotte Fire Department, where he commands the 4th Battalion in East Charlotte that averages more than 200 working structure fires each year. His firehouse responds to 9,000 emergencies each year.

Clumpner has undergraduate degrees in fire science, paramedicine, and business administration, a master's degree in business administration and a Ph.D. in homeland security policy. His dissertation research focused on joint public safety response protocols for active shooter events, and he has spent more than 20,000 hour researching active shooters and active shooter response.

He has been a guest expert on radio and television programs and published multiple articles in peer-reviewed journals throughout the world. He has authored or coauthored 10 textbooks on emergency medicine, critical care medicine, and homeland security. Clumpner has lectured extensively throughout North America, Latin America, Europe, the Middle East, Australia, New Zealand and the Caribbean, presenting at more than 300 major conferences and symposiums.
