Lexington County's Postconstruction Stormwater **Control Structure Maintenance Program**

Lexington County has more than 700 post-construction stormwater control structures, or SCSs, in its MS4 that treat stormwater runoff from impervious areas. Although the County's Land Development Manual requires all SCSs to be inspected and maintained annually, the county has for many reasons historically struggled ensuring they are maintained. Many had become so overgrown they were barely visible. Lexington County developed a database of SCSs across the MS4, providing annual mailings to private pond owners reminding them of annual inspection and maintenance requirements. The newly developed Stormwater BMP Editor App in ArcGIS Online allows the county to track inspection and maintenance progress and identify where enforcement is needed.
