The Home Jurisdiction Notice of Suspension are now being sent to the SCDMV electronically.

These notices will not be sent for cases in which the disposition has been rejected by the SCDMV and are listed on the CMS eDisposition Reporting Portal.

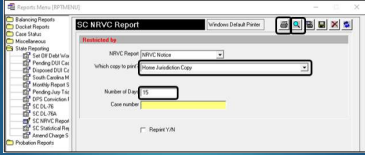
Once the error is corrected, the Home Jurisdiction copy will be transmitted to the SCDMV the next time notices are generated.

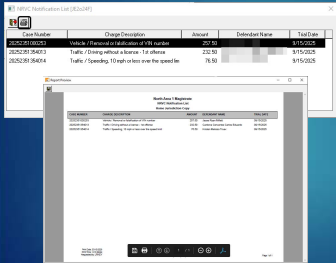

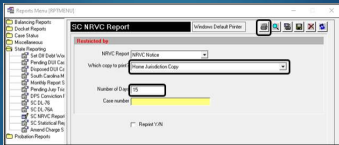

Home Jurisdiction Copy – NRVC #2 Exceptions List

Cases that are on the eDisposition Error Log or have a disposition greater than 1 year will not be sent to the DMV and will be displayed on the Exceptions list. Print the exceptions list. Close the print preview and exceptions list. eDispositions errors must be resolved. After errors have been corrected the NRVC Home Jurisdiction copy process can be rerun.

NOTES: If the eDisposition is not correct, the cases will continue to appear on the NRVC Notification and Exceptions list each time the NRVC Home Jurisdiction report is generated.

Home Jurisdiction Suspension Withdrawal – NRVC #3

If the defendant holds a South Carolina driver's license and the original Home Jurisdiction Copy – NRVC #2 was transmitted electronically, the Home Jurisdiction Suspension Withdraw notice will be electronically sent to the SCDMV once full payment is posted to the case.

During the payment process, Home Jurisdiction Suspension Withdraw notice will automatically print and should be given to the defendant.

NOTE: Out-of-State drivers are responsible for submitting the Home Jurisdiction Suspension Withdraw notice to their state of record.

- Deleted – The NRCV record was deleted from the case in CMS.
- cDisposition Error – The Home Jurisdiction copy was not sent to the SCDMV due to an error on the cDisposition Error Log. Refer to the CMS cDisposition Reporting Portal Correcting Errors Reference Guide.

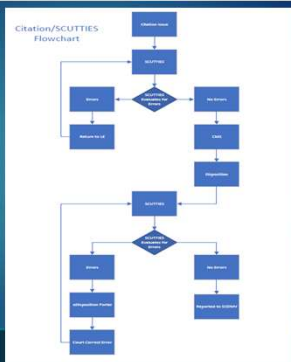

Citation/eCitations

- When a citation is pulled into CMS via the eCitation screen do not change any citation information.
- The citation in CMS should be the same information received by the Defendant and issued by the officer. If changes have been made when the disposition is submitted to SCDMV, the conviction will be rejected.
- When citations are imported through CMS eCitation Case Entry, a record is created in the eCitation Audit Tracking Log.

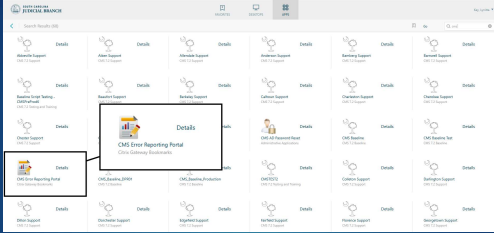

If the audit copy of the citation has a statute that does not have a CDR code or the penalty section. At the request of the DMV The officer must request the citation be deleted from SCUTTIES. Once deleted, the citation must be reentered with the correct information. **(Do NOT delete the case from CMS)** After reentry, the court should resubmit the case through the error portal.

If the **audit copy** of the citation includes a statute with a **valid CDR code**, the **case must be updated** to reflect that statute. Use **Amend Charge Secured** or the **Amend Charge Workaround**, as appropriate. Once the case has been updated, it may be **resubmitted through the error portal**.

Note: This rule does **not apply** if the defendant **pled to a new charge** and a new citation wasn't issued. (charge was amended on the current ticket)
The court must contact the DMV prior to sending a certified copy of the disposition.

If the **audit copy** of the citation includes a statute with a **valid CDR code**, and the case was **reduced to a new charge on the same ticket**, the **court must contact the DMV**.

If the **conviction statute** is different from the **issuing statute**, a **new citation must be issued**.

Examples (Require New Citation):

- DUS reduced to No SC DL
- OUV reduced to No Proof of Insurance
- DUI reduced to DUAC

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Fines and Cost

The South Carolina General Assembly sets the maximum and minimum fine ranges for traffic tickets, misdemeanors, and felonies within the South Carolina Code of Laws.

Judge discretion: Within statutory limits, individual judges or magistrates have the final authority to decide the exact base fine amount based on the facts of the case

State surcharges: South Carolina law tacks mandatory state assessments and surcharges onto the base fine. A standard criminal or traffic surcharge of 107.5% is common, which can more than double the base fine amount.

Additional flat or percentage fees are added to fund specific state programs, such as the victim assistance fund, breathalyzer/crime lab analyses, and drug treatment programs.

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Fines and Cost

Fine, Court Cost, Assessments and Surcharges

It is a misdemeanor for any person to violate any of the provisions of this chapter unless such violation is by this chapter or other law of this State declared to be a felony.

Every person convicted of a misdemeanor for a violation of any of the provisions of this chapter for which another penalty is not provided shall be punished by a fine of not more than one hundred dollars or by imprisonment for not more than thirty days.

SECTION 56-1-460. Penalties for driving while license cancelled, suspended or revoked; route restricted license.

(A)(1) Except as provided in item (2), a person who drives a motor vehicle on a public highway of this State when the person's license to drive is canceled, suspended, or revoked must, upon conviction, be punished as follows:

(a) for a first offense, **fined three hundred dollars** or imprisoned for up to thirty days, or both;

(b) for a second offense, **fined six hundred dollars** or imprisoned for up to sixty consecutive days, or both; and

(c) for a third or subsequent offense, **fined one thousand dollars, and** imprisoned for up to ninety days or confined to a person's place of residence pursuant to the Home Detention Act for up to ninety days. No portion of a term of imprisonment or confinement under home detention may be suspended by the trial judge except when the court is suspending a term of imprisonment upon successful completion of the terms and conditions of confinement under home detention. For purposes of this item, a person sentenced to confinement pursuant to the Home Detention Act is required to pay for the cost of such confinement.

(d) Notwithstanding the provisions of Sections 22-3-540, 22-3-545, 22-3-550, and 14-25-65, an offense punishable under this item may be tried in magistrates or municipal court.
