Local ordinances play a pivotal role in shaping the adoption and effectiveness of green stormwater infrastructure within communities. This session will explore the dual impact of local regulations, examining how ordinances can both facilitate and impede the use of GSI. Attendees will gain an understanding of the mechanisms by which ordinances can mandate or incentivize GSI in new developments, establish clear design and maintenance standards, and integrate GSI into broader planning frameworks. It will also address common regulatory barriers, such as restrictive zoning, inflexible stormwater requirements, and complex permitting processes. Through case studies and practical recommendations, the session will provide insights for developing ordinances supporting resilient, sustainable and community-focused stormwater solutions.
