- 1-Sprains/strains
 - 2-Slip, trips, and falls
 - 3-Motor vehicle collisions

Drilldown by Department

Department	Cause of Injury
Police	Slips, trips and falls
Fire	Sprains, strains/lifting, pushing or pulling
Public Works	Vehicle collisions

Auto Physical Damage (since 1/1/23)

- 1-Hit stationary object \$1.6M
- 2-Interscction –at fault \$1.2M
- 3-Struck bird/animal \$1.1M



Auto Liability (since 1/1/23)

- 1-Intersection –at fault \$4.2M
- 2-Rearended other veh \$2.5M
- 3-Failed to yield ROW \$1.2M

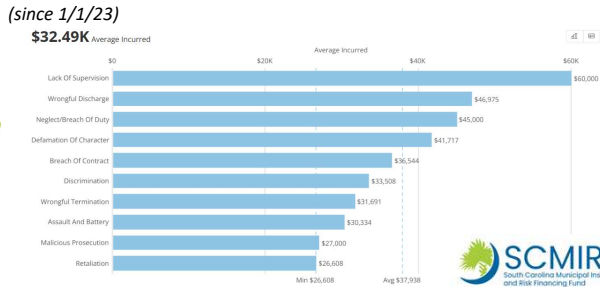


General Liability Claims (since 1/1/23)

- 1-Slip, trip, or fall \$3.8M
- 2-Sewer backup \$1.5M
- 3-Damaged waterlines \$843k

What should I take from this?

- What training/communication do we do on preventing **slips, trips and falls** and/or **strains/sprains**?
- How often do we do safety inspections of our workplaces?
- Does the PD train on slip, trips, falls?
- When someone does fall or has a strain injury, do we do good incident investigations and reviews to fix what caused the slip, trip or fall?



What should I take from this?



- What is our position on distracted driving? Do we allow hands free or do we require employee to pull over to use phone? Do we enforce our written policy?
- What does our training/communication for distracted driving look like?
- What expectations do we set for employees who drive municipal vehicles?



What should I take from this?



- Do we do routine inspections of sidewalks and address areas of concern or report them to SCDOT or appropriate party and keep proof?
- Do we do routine inspections of public areas and address concerns, keeping documentation?
- Do we have a sewer system risk mitigation plan?



What should I take from this?





- When we promote an employee to a leadership position, what training do we provide related to:
 - ✓ Managing performance
 - ✓ Hiring/firing
 - ✓ Respect in the workplace (Anti-harassment)
